The Wallaby Creek festival is run by the Cape York Folk Club., which is a group of local, hard-working, fun-loving volunteers. We endeavour to provide a broad range of stalls and opportunities for festival goers. Every attempt is made to provide a fair and equitable opportunity for all applicants. If you're selling something unique, it is handcrafted, and you provide an opportunity for festival goers to interact with your craft, we want you at our festival. All funds raised go to supporting Cape York Folk Club Inc and next year's festival.

Stall Fees as per following:

- 3mx 3m stall \$150 (+GST) + receive 1 festival pass
- 6m x 3m stall \$300 (+ GST) + receive 2 festival passes
Larger by negotiation

Stall Discounted Ticketing

Stallholder family & staff get 30% off ticket cost. There are limits to how many people may assist you.

Discount Tickets Price

- **Adults** -\$190
- **Youth** - \$95 (ID required)
- **Children** - \$5 per child

Stall Invoice:

We will send an invoice if your stall has been accepted. The invoice includes full costing of your stall, electricity & staff. When the invoice has been paid in full, we will issue your discount tickets

Non-Negotiable points:

- Packaging and carry bags, food, drink containers and cutlery must be compostable or recyclable.
- NO GLASS, NO war toys
- Ideally Plastic Free

Stalls unable to comply will be charged an extra \$100 Trash Tax.

Electrical and Gas Equipment Requirements for stalls

- All **Electrical equipment** must have a current 'test and tag' prior to installation on site.
- All **Gas equipment** must meet current standards and regulations.
- Operators must provide their own lighting if required in their stall.

Minimum Trading Hours

- **Friday 25**— merchandise stalls between **8am** to **7pm**. Food stalls from as early as **6 am to 9 pm or later if you wish.**

- **Saturday 26** - merchandise stalls between **7am to 7pm**. Food stalls from as early as **6 am to 9 pm or later if you wish**.
- **Sunday 27**- merchandise and food stalls between **7am to 5pm** unless staying the night (food stalls encouraged).
- **Monday 28** - **Food stalls welcome to stay Sunday night**

Access and setup for stallholders

- Stall holders can **set up Tuesday 8am to Thursday midday**. All vehicles **MUST** be secured in stalls area by 12 pm midday Thursday and are not permitted to move until Sunday 5pm. Any drop off delivery of goods into the stalls area will need to be by foot.
- When calculating the **size of your stall area** please include all ropes and awnings, your vehicle and camping needs. The organisers reserve the right to relocate a stallholder to another stall space within the festival if deemed necessary for the smooth running of the event.
- You have the option of camping in the West Camp area as **not all stalls have camping located directly behind** them. If you are camping behind your stall, please be considerate if entertaining after hours.
- **Parking** - Stallholders/family and staff are to park extra vehicles in the Day Parking.
- **Public Liability insurance** Please email your current certificate of insurance. My Market Insurance offer competitive rates .

Cancelling your Stall at WCF - If the stallholders wish to cancel this agreement 30 days or less before the festival they will not be refunded any stall fees.

- **WCF takes no responsibility for any damage occurring to stalls, merchandise or theft**. We do have paid security that patrol the festival at night.
- **Reminder this is an ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY FESTIVAL** We ask that if you have large plastic containers that you take them with you.
- Subletting your stall is not permitted. ● No fires at the stall area please. ● No amplifiers or loudspeakers
- **Zero tolerance** to abusive, bullying, or disruptive behaviour.
